WHAT IS NARCAN?

NARCAN (Naloxone) is a nasal spray for emergency treatment of an opioid overdose

NARCAN MAY BE NEEDED IF:

Someone has shallow, slow, or looks like they're not breathing

Has no response when trying to wake them up

And/or has very small pupils with difficulty waking up

HOW TO USE NARCAN

NARCAN can be used by anyone, including family members

Give NARCAN right away, and get emergency care after
